CHARACTERS:

TIFFANY

I feel like this is the *end* of time. (Beat) You sound so heartless. Don't say such things on a day like this.

ROBERT

(Beat) You believe in God, don't you Tiffany?

TIFFANY

Of course, but what does that have to do with it. Robert don't you say anything against God!

ROBERT

Do you believe that all things, all events are predetermined? Planned out by God. All written down in some book somewhere.

TIFFANY

Yes, but what does that have to do with anything?

ROBERT

What if all of those people had to die? That it was predetermined, by God or fate or whatever you want to call it.

TIFFANY

Huh?

ROBERT

TIFFANY

ROBERT

You know answer, don't you Tiff?

TIFFANY

TIFFANY

ROBERT

TIFFANY

ROBERT

TIFFANY

ROBERT
